ORDER:

In the Government Order first and second read above, orders were issued for the sanction of Rs.1 Crore to formulate the new Welfare Schemes for Non Resident people of Tamil Nadu with a revolving nature and powers were delegated to the Director, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non Resident Tamils, Chennai to operate the above fund upto Rs.50 lakh as and when necessity arises and in respect of expenditure exceeding Rs.50 lakh it should be referred to Government for issue of relevant orders.

2. In the reference third read above, the Director, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non Resident Tamils was permitted to draw an amount of Rs.10,59,866/-(recouped) and deposit the funds in to the Personal Deposit Account already maintained by him as revolving fund.

3. In the letter fourth read above, the Director, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non Resident Tamils, Chennai has informed that an amount Rs.14,71,064/- has been utilized from the amount of Rs.1Crore sanctioned and a balance of Rs.85,28,936/- is available in the Revolving Fund. Subsequently, as ordered in the Government order first read above, the expenditure of Rs.14,71,064/- has to be recouped into Revolving Fund of Rs.1 Crore. The Government has accordingly recouped the fund of Rs.1 Crore and included in the Budget Estimate 2018-2019. The Director, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non Resident Tamils, Chennai has requested the Government to issue fresh orders empowering to draw and deposit the funds allotted in the Personal Deposit Account already maintained by him.

4. The Government, after careful examination accept the request of the Director, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non Resident Tamils and to permit to draw and deposit the fund in the Personal Deposit Account already maintained by him. The expenditure of Rs.14,71,064/- (re-couped) (Rupees fourteen lakh seventy one thousand and sixty four only) as revolving funds shall be debited under the following head of account:-

2235-Social Security And Welfare-01- Rehabilitation - 800 –Other expenditure –State’s Expenditure – AI-Transportations of deceased Non Resident Tamils / Repatriation of Tamil Nationals in distress/medical invalidation 3-51 compensation – 02- Other compensation Old DPC 2235-01-800-AI-5121 (IFHRMS.DCP.2235 01-800- AI-35102)

5. The Director, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non Resident Tamils is requested to follow the conditions stipulated in the G.O. first read above, scrupulously.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (PUB) Department vide its U.O. Note No.20235/Finance (PUB)/2019, dated 12.07.2019.
