From the Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non-Resident Tamils, Chepauk, Chennai-5, letter No.1/2168/2014, dated.26.03.2014.

ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner, Commissionerate of Rehabilitation and Welfare of Non Resident Tamils has, among others, requested the Government to provide funding of Rs.1.00 crore initially as 'Revolving fund' to meet out the expenditure with respect to transportation of the mortal remains of the deceased Non-Resident Tamils, and for repatriation of Non-Resident Tamils in distress/medical invalidation, for the eligible cases, in view of financial hardships faced by the affected Non-Resident Tamils / their families.

2. While moving Demand No.38 in respect of Public Demand (2014-2015) on the Floor of the Legislative Assembly on 12.08.2014, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced that Rupees one crore will be sanctioned as one-time grant for creation of a 'Revolving Fund' to incur expenditure for the transportation of mortal remains of the deceased Non-Resident Tamils and for repatriation of Tamil Nationals in distress/medical invalidation.

3. The Government, after careful examination, accord sanction of a sum of Rs. 1 crore (Rupees one crore) initially as one-time grant for creation of a Revolving fund for implementing the schemes of transportation of mortal remains of the deceased Non-Resident Tamils and for repatriation of Tamil Nationals in distress/medical invalidation and the successive fund will be utilized to meet out the needs of deserving Non-Resident Tamils by the Budget provision. The amount released from the "Revolving Fund" can be recouped as and when the funds are received from the various schemes of the Government. The fund will be controlled
